- Committed to reducing stigma, building supportive communities & ensuring no one faces grief alone

7 Treasurer's report

- Outlining key financial highlights in he impact report
- Goal was to return a surplus of circa \$100k
- Confirmed funding is predominantly (85%) sourced from governments grants, however majority of this is to deliver programs for government
- GL has experienced cost pressures like many other business, despite this, still managed to return a surplus
- Funding is currently due to expire at the conclusion of current financial year
- Mental health commonwealth funding outcomes will be learned in February – we have put in a comprehensive submission & hopeful of a favourable outcome
